Supervision is exercised over the work of Bus Drivers, Mechanics, and other Transportation Department personnel. The work is performed under the general direction of the Chief Administration Officer, with a high level of autonomy performed collaboratively with the District Executive Team.

The successful applicant will have the proven ability to build a community of school bus drivers, aides, mechanics, and clerical colleagues devoted to best practices in transportation services including; an overriding emphasis on safety, development of a culturally responsive and inclusive transportation experience for all students as individuals.

Candidates must also satisfy the requirements for School Bus Driver as set forth in the Rules and Regulations of the New York State Commissioner of Education, State Education Law and the Vehicle and Traffic Law.
